We have been keeping an eye on the new construction at the Allenberry Resort, in Boiling Springs, PA. This facility is an expansion of what was the Playhouse – a famed summer stock theater. We are considering this venue for a December Christmas party and facility tour.

5. SPECIAL PROJECTS:

CDT Boot Camp – We are still working through a change in approach for our Chapter. In the past, we conducted an eight week course in January and February.

Exhibitors' Show - Our annual Exhibitor's Show was a success this year despite the snow storm that caused us to delay the event until May. We partnered with the American Society of Refrigeration and Air Conditioning Engineers (ASRAE) in bringing in a speaker to offer an AIA/CES course on geothermal heating. Both professional societies were so pleased with the result; we plan on partnering again for the 2018 show.

Long Range Planning – The chapter has begun to use SurveyMonkey to conduct surveys of the membership to formulate long term planning objectives. After our first attempt, we have found we need to develop a multiple choice questionnaire rather than an open ended questionnaire for write-in answers.
